Taylor Brady is the co-founder of the nonprofit organization Bored No More (www.BoredNoMoreCharity.org). She raises money to sponsor *Kids Care* tote bags full of fun, health & wellness toys and games that she donates to pediatric patients in hospitals throughout the U.S.

Items are carefully selected, including PopSockets, mini Etch-A-Sketches, Play-Doh, coloring books and crayons, that help reduce anxiety, create a more fun experience, and bring joy to kids during hospital stays. The nonprofit has already impacted over 3,500 patients and families, having donated over 24,000 crayons, 24,000 pages of coloring books, 3,000 tubs of Play-Doh, 3,000 card games, and more.
